City Council to Consider Extension of Stay-at-Home Order

Will Islands be Protected?

The Portland City Council will be meeting this Monday night, March 30th, at 5:00pm. The meeting will be accessible to the public by Zoom. There will be opportunity for public comment.

Being considered is the extension of the current Stay-at-Home order which expires today.

Does the order offer sufficient protections to the Portland Island communities dependent on the lifelines of ferries and barges for their food, fuel?

How will the order help the City cope with the expected influxes of vacationers during the coming months?

You have an opportunity to make your thoughts known on these questions.

Order 153-19/20 Renewing and Amending the Proclamation Declaring Continued State of Emergency and Requirement to Stay at Home - Sponsored by Kate Snyder, Mayor

On March 24, 2020, City Manager Jon P. Jennings, issued a proclamation declaring a continued state of emergency and a requirement to stay at home.

This order extends the proclamation for twenty-eight (28) days, through April 27, 2020.

Seven votes are required for passage as an emergency following public comment.
